## Information Board

### Deacon Recommendation

The Deacons are recommending to our church members to support a vote to expend funds (not to exceed \$30,000) from our savings to repair roof leaks on both the main Church building (31 Ferman) and the Ministry Action Center (MAC – 36 Tolan). You may pick up absentee ballots after church today or 9/9 from Jaime McDonald, our church clerk; Jaime will be in the church office after each worship service. All absentee ballots are to be returned to Jaime by the start of the worship service on 9/16. All other members can pick up their ballot after the worship service on 9/16 and return to Jaime at that time. The results will be announced on 9/23. Given that this will cut deeply into our savings, we’re asking the congregation to prayerfully consider going above and beyond their normal offerings to financially contribute towards “Church Roof” to replenish these funds. Anything so designated will be tracked and reported in the bulletin until we cover the cost of the repairs.
