A Word from Our Pastor 10/24/21

The Psalmist said, "Oh give thanks to the LORD, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever! ²Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, whom he has redeemed from trouble ³ and gathered in from the lands, from the east and from the west, from the north and from the south." (Psalm 107:1-3 ESV)

The WHY, WHO, and WHEN of this Psalm are all unknown. Psalm 107, teaches not only that God's providence WATCHES over us but also that His ear is always open to HEAR our prayer. The Psalmists theme here is the unfailing faithfulness of God.

The Psalmist gives us an exhortation in vv.1-3, to... "¹agive thanks to the LORD." Unfortunately, gratitude is a forgotten attitude in our day. I've hear it said, "Giving thanks to the Lord is the MOST we can give Him and the LEAST we should give Him." Praise and thanks to God should be given, both with our LIPS and with our LIVES." In the second half of v.1 we see two reasons for thanking God..."¹b for He is good, for his steadfast love (mercy) endures forever!"

As believers, we are the recipients of God's goodness and mercy. It was Charles H. Spurgeon who said it best, "Whatever others may think or say, as believers, we have overwhelming reasons for declaring the goodness and the mercy of God from the depths of our soul." Think about folks, the LORD has liberated us from the bondage and penalty of sin. The apostle Paul wrote, "But now we are released from the law, having died to that which held us captive, so that we serve in the new way of the Spirit and not in the old way of the written code." (Romans 7:6 ESV; also, Hebrews 2:14-15)

As believers, we have every reason to sing and proclaim the gospel to our world! So, why are we not doing it? Let me encourage you today to fill your heart with gratitude for what the Lord has done for us and is doing in us and then share it with everyone you meet!

Psalms 40:3 ESV

"He put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to our God. Many will see and fear and put their trust in the LORD."


