

Nine Minutes



There are 9 minutes during the day that have the greatest impact on a child:

- **The first 3 minutes right after they wake up**
- **The 3 minutes after they come home from school**
- **The last 3 minutes of the day before they go to bed.**

Make those minutes special and help our children feel special, loved, and accepted.

Each day children need meaningful eye-to-eye conversations with a parent. It is especially important to slow down and look for them in the eye. Listen and respond with love.

Hug your child, straighten her hair, pat him on the back and tell them how proud you are of him everyday. A simple touch makes them feel connected to a parent in ways that words never will.

And most importantly, pray for your children.

Remember, actions speak louder than words!
